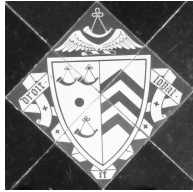


8 FLOOR TILES

Find a pattern of tiles like the ones shown.

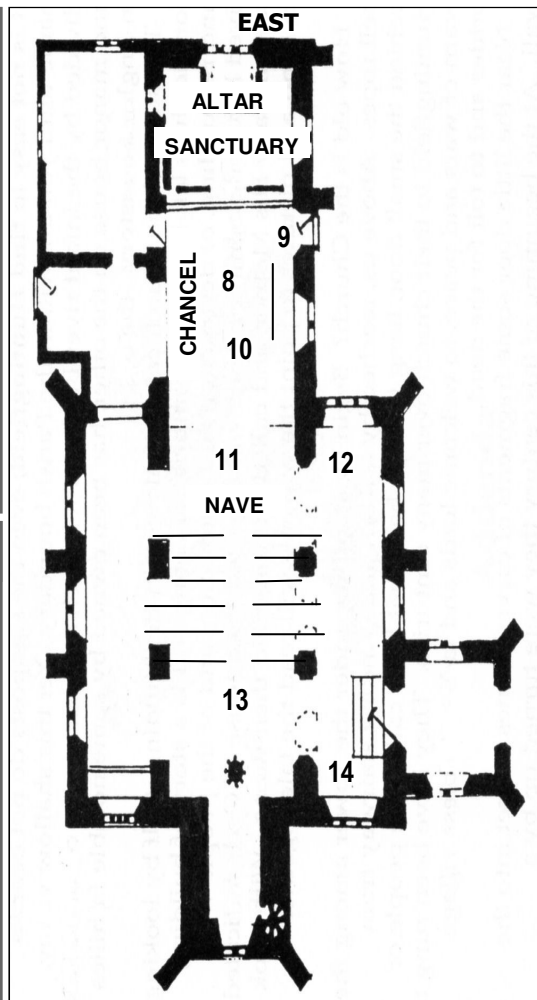
How many sets of this tile pattern are there here?
