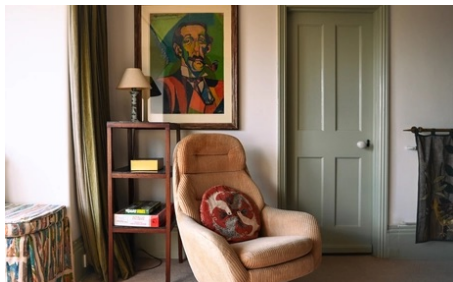


VISIT...

Wednesday 21st May (10-12 noon)

"The eclectic range of pieces on show reflects a combination of the personal tastes of Britten and Pears, their working relationships with artists, and their friends at the heart of the art scene in the mid-20th century. While landscapes and figurative subjects dominate, there are a small number of important abstracts."*

We will see work by John Piper, Sidney Nolan, Christian Rohlf, Georg Ehrlich and Mary Potter.

Guided tours of the house, the library, the composition studio and a story from the archive of Britten's record of the artworks.
